MEMBERSHIP 1st April 2019 - 31st March 2020

Extract from the Constitution of the AHCS adopted on 12 April 2013, and amended on 13 September 2014:

3. MEMBERSHIP

(i). Full Membership will be open to any Society or Association in Scotland or the UK representing the members of any Highland Clan (see Clause 4 for definitions), or to the Chief or Commander of a Highland Clan without a functioning membership body. Each clan holding full membership will be entitled to one vote on the governing Council of the Association, and a full discount on all services and goods provided by AHCS.

(ii). Associate Membership will be open to Societies, Associations, and other bodies interested in or associated with the activities of the AHCS, and accepted as such by the Council of AHCS. Bodies holding Associate Membership may nominate a non-voting representative to sit on the Council of AHCS, and will receive a full discount on all services and goods provided by AHCS.

(iii). Individual Membership will be open to individual members of clans holding full membership, or anybody bearing a Highland name not formally associated with a clan that has full membership of the AHCS. Individual Members will be able to attend and be heard at the AGM of the AHCS; will be eligible for election to an office of the AHCS; and will receive a full discount on all goods and services provided by AHCS.

4. DEFINITIONS

(i). In the context of the AHCS, "Highland" refers to the *Gaidhealtachd* or the area north and west of the *Highland Line*.

AHCS aims to organise at least three regular annual events (Culloden Weekend in April, the Clan Tent at the Inverness Highland Games in July, Autumn Social & AGM in September/October). While non-member clans/societies and individuals will always be welcome at our events, clans/societies belonging to AHCS will receive priority for places at the Inverness Games (and any other events where clans/societies are represented), and discounts on any fees payable for participation. Members of clans/societies belonging to AHCS, along with individual members of AHCS, will usually receive discounts on any tickets to events organised and financed by the Association.

Use this form to book your place in the AHCS big tent at the Inverness Highland Games to be held this year at Bught Park on the 20th July. It is expected that the arrangements will be the same as last year, with 20 pitches available in the clan tent - first come, first served, so get your reservation in ASAP - and with set-up only on Saturday morning (not on Friday evening).

It is expected that each clan will receive 4 passes into the games, and will have the use of two tables and four chairs in the tent. Confirmation of what is being provided, times for set-up, and any other conditions will be notified to those who have booked places shortly before the games.
